- Sacristy door update – still need to get template of arch above window before project can be completed.

**Committee Updates**

- *Faith Formation:* Faith formation on Wednesdays has resumed, could use some extra members to help. Rick & Julie passed out prolife materials and held a rosary. All Saints Day, no extra mass – All Souls Day, evening mass & Thanksgiving Mass at Central City at 8:30am. Catechists are looking for ideas on teaching material. Planning on have a family faith formation on Wednesdays prior to children's faith formation.
- *Stewardship:* Fall cleanup project for elderly – Carol reached out to some parishioners, there were four that could use some help. Julie & Carol are planning to send cards/notes to parishioners in senior centers and assisted living centers.

- Finance: Discussed fundraising, what can and cannot be done due to COVID. Preparing mailings, speakers & masses for appeal in November & December. Windows for parish were put on hold until a later date due to lack of availability.
- School Board: Surpassed goal on fundraising selling Edgewood meat & Club Choice. Recent clothing order was placed with each student receiving \$7 off per shirt from St Patrick's Alum. Kids will be having costume parade & Halloween activities, and all are attending mass on Thursdays. Government extended free lunches to the end of school year.
